FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Can I bring my luggage on the bus?
 NO, luggage is not permitted on the bus, it is a safety issue.
- Have the bus departure times changed?
 NO, the departure times remain the same, and are posted at camp and online.
- Can I get a boarding pass without a booked flight?

NO, you must be booked on a flight to be issued a boarding card. Please contact your travel coordinator if you do not have a travel itinerary booked.

- Is there storage for me to leave my stuff?
 Yes, go to security and they will facilitate.
- What if my name is spelled incorrectly on my flight itinerary?

The name on your flight itinerary MUST match your government issued identification. You will NOT receive a boarding pass until your identification matches your itinerary. Please contact your flight coordinator prior to checking in if your name is spelled incorrectly or does not match your itinerary.

WHAT IS NOW REQUIRED TO CHECK-IN FOR YOUR FLIGHT?

Government issued identification

You must have a flight reservation to obtain a boarding pass.

Your government issued ID must match your flight reservation

CHANGES AT CAMP

- Boarding passes will be issued at the Flight Centre at each camp.
- Flight Centre check-in hours will be extended; however, luggage cut off times and bus departures will remain unchanged.
- You MUST have a government issued ID to be issued a boarding card.
- There will be two check-in lanes: express (for passengers without checked luggage), and a line for those checking luggage.
- Passengers will be required to tag their own luggage once they have checked in and are issued bag tags.

CHANGES AT THE AERODROME

- Passengers will no longer need to line up and check-in at the Aerodrome.
- More seating will be available at the Aerodrome while waiting for boarding announcements to begin.
- A passenger service Help Desk is available for all issues such as lost boarding passes, day travelers, and any questions or concerns.
- Once boarding begins, passengers will present boarding pass at the gate and scan their Site ID badge.
