

Building Futures Scholarship Application Form

The Building Futures Scholarship is open July 10 - August 15 for the Fall semester and November 10 - December 15 for the Winter semester.

Thank you for your interest in the Building Futures Scholarship Program. Each application is reviewed by Canadian Natural's Building Futures Advisory Committee. To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must be a child or dependent student of a Canadian Natural employee and/or an Indigenous student from a community near our operations.

The Building Futures Scholarship Program contributes to the ongoing development of a qualified workforce for the future of the oil and gas industry. Canadian Natural takes great pride in investing in education and our youth, and the scholarship program is a critical part of these efforts.

Please read the criteria carefully and ensure that you follow all the instructions.

Please note that if you are awarded a scholarship, you will be required to provide your Social Insurance Number for T4A purposes.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to receive a scholarship all students must:

- 1. Be a child/dependent of a Canadian Natural employee (spouses are not eligible) and/or be an Indigenous student from a community near Canadian Natural operations.
- 2. Hold a Canadian Social Insurance Number (SIN).
- 3. Be pursuing an area of study that is relevant to the oil and gas industry and/or supports the communities where these activities occur.
- 4. Be enrolled in a minimum of three courses for the semester you are applying for.
- 5. Maintain a passing GPA of at least 2.3, which is the equivalent of approximately 70% or a C+. Official transcripts must be provided to confirm most recent GPA (electronic transcripts will be accepted).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Only one application per student will be reviewed in a calendar year.
- 2. All required fields are marked with an asterisk (*) and must be completed before submission.

3. Applications for the Fall semester are open July 10 - August 15 and applications for the Winter semester are open November 10 - December 15.

Please note that scholarships are not available for terms that include a co-op placement.

The following materials <u>must</u> be included in the application package:

- The completed application
- Up-to-date transcripts from any/all high school or post-secondary institutions you have attended in the last two years
- Proof of registration from the school you are attending for the upcoming term
- A letter of approximately one page describing your career plan and community involvement.
 Please include:
 - Information on the program you attend/plan to attend and the timeframe for the program
 - o The reason you have chosen this area of education and your long-term goals
 - Any experience you have that is relevant to your program
 - Your commitment to successfully complete the program and maintain a passing GPA of at least 2.3
 - o A description of your volunteer activities
 - Information on any hardships you face (optional)
- 1-2 reference or recommendation letters from community leaders, supervisors or teachers to support your application
