

Canadian Natural Resources Limited (Canadian Natural) Response to Forest Fires

June 3, 2025, 2:00pm

The forest fires are currently at a safe distance from Canadian Natural's Jackfish 1 thermal in situ operations with no threat to the health and safety of our staff or infrastructure. After confirming the area surrounding our operations was safe to access, Canadian Natural completed an assessment of the Jackfish 1 facility and equipment.

On June 2, with safety as a core value, our operational staff commenced start-up activities at Jackfish 1 with ramp up over the next several days and targeting full bitumen production of approximately 36,500 bbl/d by June 6.

Canadian Natural is prepared with comprehensive plans in place should conditions change that pose a risk to our teams and/or operations. We thank our teams and service providers for their focus on ensuring safe, reliable operations as well as the firefighters and first responders dedicated to battling the forest fires in the region.

In response to forest fires in northern Alberta, Canadian Natural has taken precautionary measures to protect the safety of our people and our assets.

Canadian Natural has safely evacuated workers from our Jackfish 1 thermal in situ operations and completed the safe, temporary shut-in of approximately 36,500 bbl/d of bitumen production. All workers are safe and accounted for with no reported injuries and have been relocated to other facilities in our thermal in situ operations.

Canadian Natural is working together with local authorities to ensure the safe and orderly movement of people through the area, including providing support for first responders and community members. We wish to thank firefighters and emergency responders for their efforts in battling the forest fires.
