<p>COMMENTS:</p> 	<p>Effective Monday June 20th, 2022 Covid-19 testing will no longer be carried out at any of CNRL’s air terminals. However, passengers are advised that Transport Canada Regulations remain in effect until further notice.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Transport Canada approved masks must be properly worn while in all terminals and throughout the duration of the flight. <p>Passengers who do not have an approved mask will be provided with one at their departing terminal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Passengers will be required to read and acknowledge the posted mandatory health check questions. <p>To help prevent the spread of COVID-19, all air travellers must answer the following Transport Canada Health Check questions:</p> <table border="0"> <tr> <td style="vertical-align: top;"> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 You exhibit a fever and a cough or a fever and breathing difficulties? 2 You have COVID-19 or have had it within the previous 10 days, or have reasonable grounds to suspect that you have COVID-19 or have developed signs and symptoms of COVID-19 within the previous 10 days; or 3 You have been denied permission to board an aircraft in the previous 10 days for a medical reason related to COVID-19; or 4 You are the subject of a mandatory quarantine order as a result of recent travel or as a result of a local provincial public health order. </td> <td style="vertical-align: top;"> <p>Other important information that you must confirm you understand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▶ You may be subject to a measure that the provincial, territorial or federal government has put in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19 when you arrive at your destination. ▶ All air travellers must be in possession of a mask, even if fully vaccinated. <p> Providing a false or misleading answer to any of these questions, or failure to comply with the regulations and instructions, could result in a maximum fine of \$5,000.</p> </td> </tr> </table> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ A passenger will be denied boarding if they have tested positive for Covid 19, or experienced the onset of symptoms within 10 days of their scheduled departure date or; have been subject to a mandatory quarantine order as a result of a local or provincial public health order. <p>Transport Canada has granted an exception to the above; Passengers may travel following completion of their required isolation period, as set out by their provincial or territorial health authority, before the end of the 10 day imposed TC restriction, ONLY if ALL 3 criteria are met:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Symptom free OR have a medical note certifying that any symptoms are NOT due to COVID-19. 2. - 3. All tests must be carried out by an approved facility (i.e. Shopper Drug Mart, Pharmacy etc. At home self-tests are not acceptable)
- 4. There is **NO** exception to the prohibition against travel during any applicable isolation order period, i.e., the provincial 5 days in ON or AB.

Passengers who do not comply with the Transport Canada mandates will be denied boarding.
